Laptop Scheme

- This will be our 14th year of running our laptop scheme
- The scheme is supported by monthly parental donations
- New students are invited to join a 3 year scheme, with the opportunity to renew and receive a new device for the final 2 years at Perins

Laptop Scheme

- Students participating in the scheme will receive a brand new laptop, carry case, charger, a comprehensive suite of software, support, 3 year warranty and accidental damage and theft cover
- All IT support and repairs are carried out at School by our manufacturer trained IT engineers, backed up by our close relationship with the manufacturers

Laptop Scheme

- Online safety through education, and regulation i.e. filtering, monitoring and reporting
- Students are expected to bring the laptop to school everyday, fully charged and report any damage/problems to IT Services

Laptop Scheme

- The laptop scheme enables IT to be used across the curriculum, which supports and develops different skills alongside the more traditional teaching methods
- We are unable to allow any other devices from home to be used at school

How does the scheme work?

- We ask parents to make a monthly donation, suggested £20, which is collected by our partners Freedom Tech by direct debit
- If you are a UK taxpayer, we are able to claim Gift Aid to help us support the scheme further
- The initial scheme runs for 36 months, with the direct debit starting August 2024

How does the scheme work?

- Until the end of the scheme, the laptop remains the property of Perins School
- At the end of the scheme we are usually able to offer the opportunity to retain the device for a £10 transfer of ownership fee (to comply with HMRC rules on charitable donations)

What do I need to do?

Visit the Freedom Tech portal to complete your 'order' and direct debit mandate by 26 May. The portal orders are then used by us to place our total order with the manufacturer on 5th June
